

Cranbourne East Secondary College Instrumental Music Program

At Cranbourne East Secondary College, we offer a diverse range of instruments for students to learn. These instruments may need to be hired from the college to facilitate home practice. *Instruments offered include:*

Trumpet Percussion

Trombone Drum Kit

Alto and Tenor Saxophone Piano

Clarinet Voice

Flute Guitar/Bass

Instrument Trials:

Students interested in learning an instrument will receive a free trial lesson on an instrument of their choice.



Financial Contributions:

To participate in the instrumental music program, there is a financial contribution of \$120 per semester. This contribution covers expert instruction, access to practice rooms, as well as ensemble participation.

Concert Band and other Ensembles

As part of the instrumental music program at Cranbourne East Secondary College, students have the opportunity to be part of several ensembles including a **30-piece concert band.** These ensembles provide a platform for students to showcase their musical skills and perform at various school events and concerts.

- Guitar Ensemble
- Year 9 Band
- Year 10 Band



Lesson Schedule:

Lessons for instrumental music are scheduled during the school day. Students will be assigned a lesson time during which they will come out of half of a normal period to have their music lesson. Sessions rotate each week, so students do not miss the same subject twice.





Instrument Hire:

As part of the CESC instrumental music program, students may be required to hire specialist instruments to facilitate home-practice, performance opportunities and ensemble rehearsals.
